2009 Middlemarkers Competition

For the Rabbetts Family Trophy

This club competition is open to riders who have **never** beaten 25 minutes for a Ten mile Time Trial or 1 hour 5 minutes for a 25 mile Time Trial. The competition will be decided on the same points scoring system as the Classic League, with the following exception, in the non-club events only Wanderers are counted. i.e. if you finish 53rd in the Sussex CA, but you were the only LWCC rider in the event, you would score 20 points. Is that clear? If not please ask.

2009 Classic League Competition

The Classic League Shield is awarded on a points basis to the club member who has the best placings in a number of selected time trials on 'sporting' (or damned hard) courses.

Points are scored for finishing in the top 20 in each event i.e. a 1st place is worth 20 points; 2nd place is worth 19 points down to 1 point for 20th. Riders finishing outside the top 20 do not get any points.

This series is very popular with the local road racing community and hopefully we can put on a really good promotion this year. I am however asking for help from members of the club. We need marshals at Kennel Corner, The Roebuck and at the top of the lane before turning on to the Broyle. We also need volunteers for the following: Lead car, reserve lead car, judging at finish and an assistant to help with primes, pulling out disqualified riders (hopefully there wont be any) and some general help with setting out the course and sign on. Please let me know as soon as possible if you can help, as I am massively busy around the time of the race, not only with organisation around the events but dealing with all of the enquiries.

I intend to send a flier around the local clubs asking for advanced entries, so that we can make the signing on process easier on the night. The best possible stress buster is knowing that there are people from the club wiling to help out and that we can account for the organisation early on.
