## Minutes of Meeting held on November 30<sup>th</sup> 2010

**Minutes:** The September minutes were read out and approved by the committee.

### **ESCA President**

Following a discussion and consideration of a letter from CH, the members voted for Mick Kilby to represent LWCC as the 2011 ECSA President.

### **Membership – Hugh Procter**

The 2010 membership currently stands at 140. New membership form is to be a double sided A4 sheet (sheet 1 is membership details and sheet 2 volunteer details). A line is to be added for 'parental / guardian approval'. Existing members will be requested to complete the form annually. MW/SY to modify and update the club rules as required. ### **TT Secretary – Graham Jeffs**

All 2011 event dates have been agreed and the halls booked. The Roebuck will be used for the Crits and Circuit of Earwig. The promoters will be the same as last year with all arranged except for Laughton, Danehill, and the 10's on the 16<sup>th</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup>, 31<sup>st</sup> May. The committee suggested Martyn Crawford for Laughton and Oliver Tuckley for Danehill. We will need volunteers for the three Tens. (Note: since the Meeting, Martyn & Oliver have agreed to take on the promoter roles for Laughton and Danehill). Clive Orchard would like to purchase a trophy for the club - CM to discuss details with him. The magazine is to include a reminder of what are acceptable behaviour standards at events, especially at the start and finish areas.

### **Track and Road Secretary – Chris Hough**

A letter from the Surrey League states that we should run two events in 2011. The Crits and an LWCC promoted Surrey League Road Race. CH will look into dates; courses etc and the club will need a promoter for our SL event. Bob Evans took on this role this year.

### **Club Runs – Ian McGuckin**

The winter runs began on 3<sup>rd</sup> October although the limited numbers have been slightly disappointing.

### **Social Secretary – Simon Yates**

The 60<sup>th</sup> Birthday on the 14<sup>th</sup> November was well attended (109). The cost was £500 plus £200 for the water bottles. The awards dinner / menu info will be in the December mag.

### **Treasurer – Graham Jeffs**

Account balance figure is low following 60<sup>th</sup> plus kit & bottles order. This, along with the mag & mag postage costs led the Committee to look at the need to increase subs. A motion for the AGM was agreed.
