## 65 mile Anniversary Reliability Trial

**Sunday 20th November 2011**

**Promoted by Lewes Wanderers CC**



In celebration of the East Sussex Cycling Associations 65th anniversary the 2011 Reliability Trial for the ESCA Rally Shield will be held over a 65-mile course, with the start and finish at East Hoathly Sports Pavilion. Riders can opt to complete the course in 4 hours, 4 hours 30 minutes or 5 hours.

There are no entries on the line – all entries must be made in advance by post (email not accepted), and received no later than Friday 11th November 2011. The cost per rider is £4.00 (unchanged from 2009), with cheques made payable to 'East Sussex Cycling Association'. CTC 3rd party insurance is included in the fee for all riders with ESCA club membership.

Entrants will be required to sign on no later than **10 minutes** before their allotted departure time. In a return to a more traditional format for this 65th Anniversary edition, at sign-on you will collect your route card with a map & full description of the course detailing the location of all controls – Your route card will need to be validated at all controls & handed back to the finish timekeeper on completion of the ride.

By signing on you confirm that:

- you agree to ride in a safe manner in accordance with the law
- you agree to place no liability on the organiser, ESCA or Lewes Wanderers CC
- your name has been correctly recorded (note: for certificate production purposes)

The usual rules for reliability trials will be applied. In summary, for a ride to qualify you **MUST** complete the course & have your route card validated at all of the controls. You may **NOT** finish earlier than 10 minutes before your allotted finishing time and there is to be **no racing** between riders or teams. You must ride in a manner that is safe for you, other cyclists and all other road users.

The ESCA club with the highest number of successful finishers will hold the Rally Shield for one year. In the event of a tie, the club with the largest number of successful finishers in the two fastest groups (4 hours and 4 hours 30 minutes) will be declared the winner.

The Rally Shield will be presented to the winning club at the ESCA annual luncheon and prize presentation. Certificates for successful riders will be passed to a responsible member of your club at the luncheon.
