Open & Team wins in 2014

LWCC had 6 Open wins in 2013; 14 in 2012, 9 in 2011 and 8 in 2010

We had eight Open wins in 2014: Rob Rollings & Tom Glandfield won the ESCA Two-up; Rob Rollings won the ESCA 10; Phil Allen won the ESCA 50; Paul Gibbons won the ESCA 24-Hour; Paul Gibbons won the SCA 12-Hour; Phil Allen won the Southborough & District Wheelers 25; Jamie Lowden won the Brighton Mitre and the Catford Hill Climbs.

There were 11 Female event wins by Tamar Vanderhaas: ESCA Hardriders; September ESCA 25; ESCA Hill Climb; SCA 10; SCA 25; SCA 50; SCA Hill Climb; SCCU 25; LWCC & Open 30; Horsham Cycling 10 & Redmon CC 10.

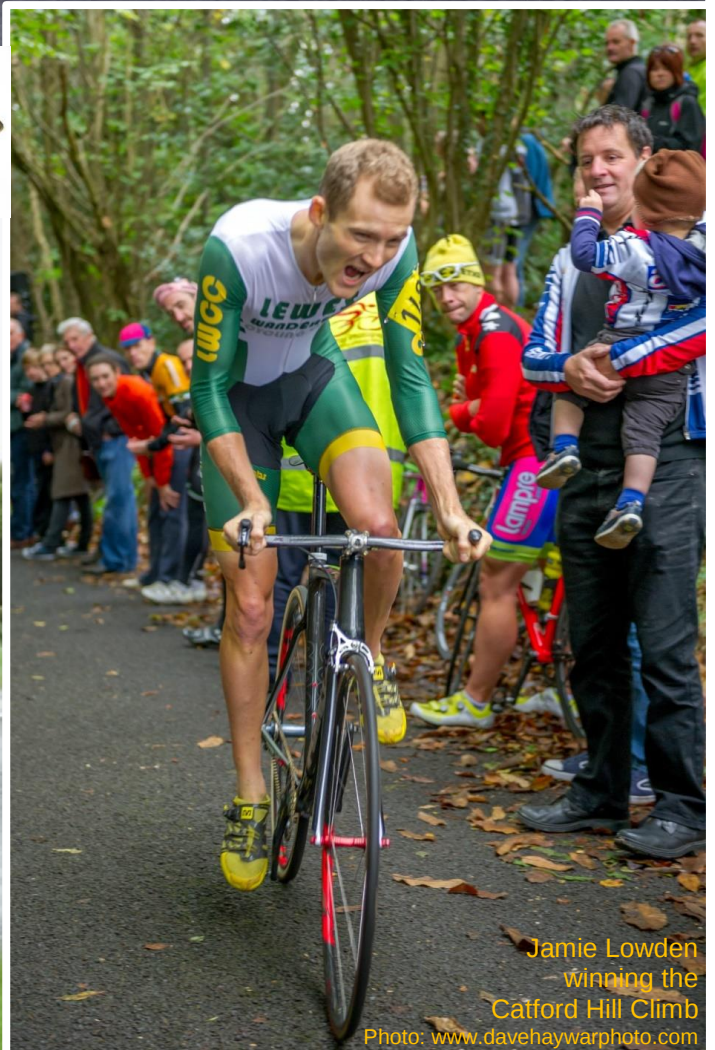
